Purpose: To view detailed information about a specific hardware asset.


## **Accessing Asset Details**

#### Steps:

On the side bar click Assets > View Hardware



• In the Hardware List, click the "View" button next to the asset you want to inspect.



# **Details Tab**


Purpose: To view basic information about the selected asset.

The "Details" tab provides information about the device, including:

- Part Number
- Manufacturer
- Description



- Image (if available)
- Current Status (e.g., in service, out of service)




#### **Associated Items**

Purpose: To view a list of additional items associated with the device.

The right-hand side of the "Details" tab displays a list of associated items, including:

- Quantity
- Serial Number
- Product Relationship Type (parent, child, or standalone)
- RACS ID (unique identifier within the system)
- Parent Instance ID (link to the parent asset, if applicable)
- Parent Serial Number
- External ID (OEM's unique identifier)
- Asset Tags
- GUID (customer identifier based on the OEM)
- Global Name
- Business Sector
- Cost Accounting Codes






## **Additional Information**


Purpose: To view warranty, networking, cost, and custom field information.

The "Details" tab also includes expandable sections for additional information:



#### **Warranty Information**


• Displays the current warranty information for the asset, including the warranty status and end date.



#### **Networking Details**




 Displays collector information about the asset, such as DNS name, IP address, and MAC address.




#### Cost

· Displays any costing details stored for the asset.



#### **Custom Fields**

• Allows you to add additional elements to any asset. Examples include department budget code and department asset retirement date.




\*\*Relevance:\*\* This allows you to track information specific to your organization's needs.

### **Asset Location**

**Purpose:** To view the physical location of the device.




- The contextual bar displays a map of where the device is physically located.
- This includes site ID, customer name, physical address, location groups, and external location names.



## **Product Information**

**Purpose:** To view detailed information about the product.

• The "Product Information" tab provides even more information about the product.





#### Item Type

 Specifies the type of item, such as chassis, line card, cable, or standalone device.

#### **Product Type**

Provides more information about the type of architecture.

#### **Product Family**

• The OEM-defined product family that belongs to this device.


#### **Architecture and Sub-Architecture Group**

 Helps in organizing devices. For example, a switch might belong to "enterprise switching" and "enterprise switch access."

#### **End-of-Life Information**

- Displays end-of-life dates, including:
  - End of Maintenance Attachment Date: When you can no longer add maintenance to a product.
  - Maintenance Renewal: When you can no longer renew a previously existing maintenance contract.
  - End of Security: When the device no longer receives security vulnerability fixes.
  - End of Software Availability Date: When the device stops getting other maintenance patches or fixes which are not security in nature.
  - End of Software Maintenance Date: When you stop getting patches or bug fixes on that particular product.
  - End of Support Date: When you can no longer call the OEM for support.
  - End of Life Notification Date: When the end-of-life notification was last posted.
  - Link to OEM Page: Direct link to the OEM page discussing the end-oflife information.
  - o Notification Number: The notification number for searching purposes.

Purpose: To access manufacturer's support resources.
